

# Sexual Health Information and Signposting Volunteer - Research and Development

**Role description:** We are looking for a small group of enthusiastic volunteers to provide a sexual health service as part of our Advice Centre. The role of research and development volunteers would be to:

- To research what other Student Unions do to promote positive sexual health
- Identify gaps in current provision of sexual health services, students' awareness of local providers and barriers to students accessing the services
- Work with providers to develop referral/signposting procedures to help students easily access relevant services
- To keep up to date with relevant news regarding young people's sexual health and working with the Media Co-ordinators to find ways of delivering these news stories to Hallam students
- To take part in stalls/events for the project subject to arrangement
- Run workshops to help raise awareness of sexual health issues as required/relevant

**Skills and experience required:**

- Enthusiastic
- Computer literate
- Confident in communicating with external agencies

**Support given:** There will be regular meetings and 1-1's with the Advice Centre Information Co-ordinator as well as a full and varied training programme
