

## Hallam Union Wins Two Prestigious Best Bar None Awards

Sheffield Hallam University's Student Union bar and nightclub has beaten stiff competition to be awarded Sheffield's Best Bar None Award in the categories of Best Bar and Best Club.

The Sheffield Best Bar None Awards are part of a national scheme, held in 80 locations across the UK. The awards were introduced to promote and encourage the responsible management of licensed premises to reduce the risk of alcohol related harm, disorder and crime to the city centre.

"It is important for Hallam Union to provide a safe and responsible bar and club, not just for the enjoyment of our students, but also for the wellbeing of the residents who we share our city with." commented Andy Farmer, Head of Commercial Services.

Bar Phoenix, came top out of 25 entries for the Best Bar Award, and Hallam Union venue beat 7 other clubs for the Best Club Award, including entries from national chains.

"We have worked really hard to meet the standards of this award and we have a better bar and venue because of it" said Phil Brown, Hallam Union Bars Manager.

To win the awards Hallam Union had to demonstrate that it adheres to Home Office approved standards in the responsible management and operation of alcohol licensed premises.
