



BYE LAW 5 UNION GENERAL MEETINGS

<p>Annual General Meeting</p>	<p>1. The Annual General Meeting shall operate in accordance with Articles 58 to 73 of the Articles of Governance</p>
<p>Extraordinary General Meeting</p>	<p>2. An Extraordinary Union General Meeting may be convened in accordance with Article 60 of the Articles of Governance</p>
<p>Rights to Attend, Speak and Vote at Union General Meetings</p>	<p>3. Full Members shall be entitled to attend, speak and vote at Union General Meetings.</p> <p>4. Associate Members, Life Members, and Opted Out Students shall;</p> <p> 4.1 be entitled to attend a Union General Meeting;</p> <p> 4.2 not be entitled to speak at a Union General Meeting (unless expressly authorised by a resolution of the Full Members present at the meeting by a Simple Majority Vote).</p> <p> 4.3 not be entitled to vote at a Union General Meeting.</p> <p>5. External trustees are entitled to attend and speak at Union General Meetings but shall not be entitled to vote.</p> <p>6. The CEO is entitled to attend and speak at Union General Meetings but shall not be entitled to vote. The CEO may delegate attendance to a nominated deputy.</p>
